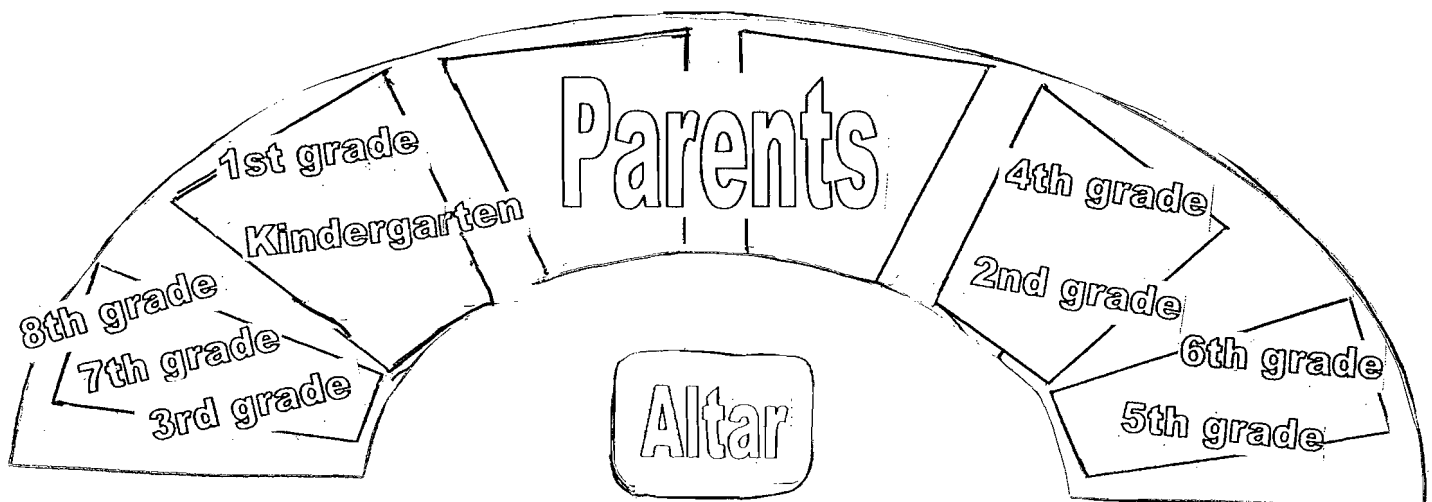
Parents, please have your student dressed in nice clothing. No jeans, no t-shirts with writing of any kind.

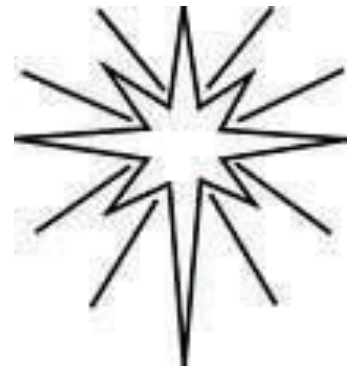
