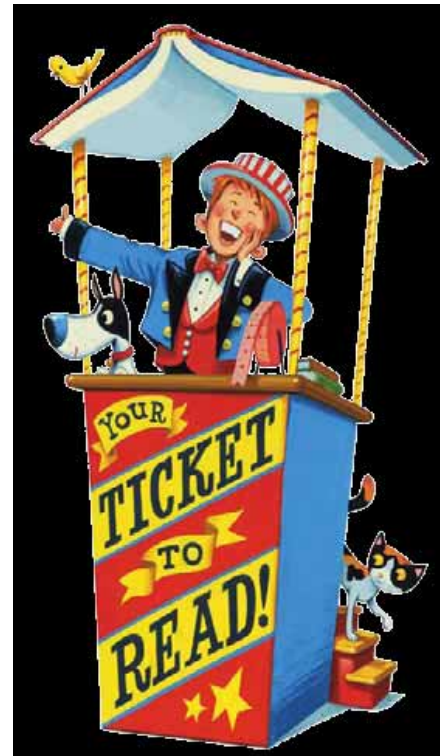
Performers need to come to school on the 1st dressed in costume for the Talent Show. Bring a change of Spirit clothes for after the show! Thank you for your cooperation.
