The Book Fair will close at 12:45 for the Faculty vs. 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Volleyball Game and reopen at 2:30pm.

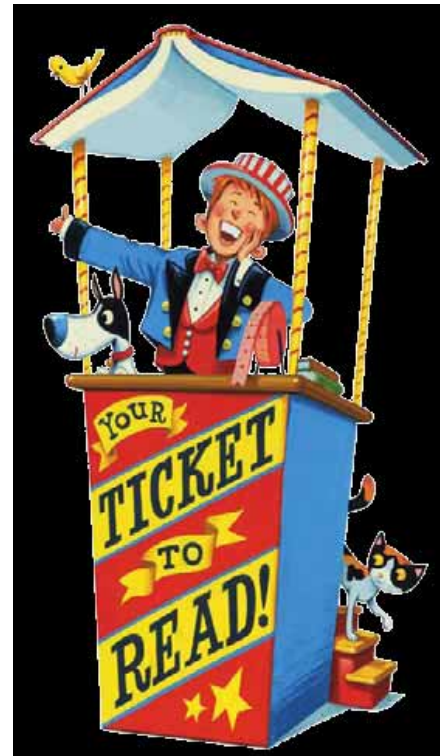

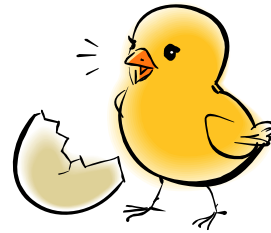
