- **Banking Box Tops** – Thank you to all the parents, grandparents, aunts, uncles and friends who turned in BoxTops this school year. St. Pius X received a 2<sup>nd</sup> check in the amount of \$912.12. That gives us a grand total of \$1,501.12 for the 2010-2011 school year! During the summer break, continue to save your BoxTops and when we return to school in August, we will put them towards the next contest we have. Be sure to write your child's name on your saved BoxTops so they will get credit. Our 2<sup>nd</sup> check will be used for technology in the Computer Lab.
- **Pius Perks – Land a New Family (K – 8) and Earn a Sizable Tuition Credit.** For every new student who enrolls attends and pays tuition in 2011-2012, a SPX School family can earn a \$250 tuition credit. For every new student in the 2011-2012 2<sup>nd</sup> grade, the tuition credit will be \$500. No limit on number of discounts which can be earned. *Please*

*note: Credit is for "new" students (that is, not returning ones). SPX families know we already offer Tulsa's most generous "multiple child discount" (more than 70 of our families benefit). We'll prorate the credit when the same new family enrolls several students. Reference needed at time of enrollment.*

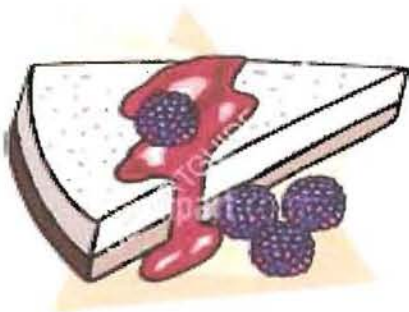
