Home & School Association Volunteer Job Descriptions

Homeroom Parent Coordinator – Ensures all grades have at least one homeroom parent and gets necessary information out to those parents in a timely manner.

Homeroom Parent – Coordinates activities for their designated classrooms/grade as directed by the school, teacher, and/or Home and School Association.

Hospitality Chairperson/Committee – Responsible for the food and beverages, and subsequent set up and clean up at various Home and School sponsored events throughout the year.

Fun Day Chairperson/Committee – Responsible for all aspects of the Fun Day carnival held the Sunday prior to Halloween including games, food, prizes, candy, and entertainment.

Feast Day Picnic Chairperson/Committee – Coordinates the planning and scheduling of a Mass in conjunction with a school-wide picnic which includes food, games and activities.

New Families Event Chairperson/Committee – Plans an event and secures family sponsors for new families to meet each other, current school patrons, the teachers and other children from their children's grades.

New Family Sponsor – Serves as a resource for a new school family through phone calls, introductions to others and time spent together at school functions.

Community Builder Dinner Chairperson/Committee – Plans and executes one dinner for the school community to enjoy together.

Spirit Night Coordinator – Reserves a location for the monthly Spirit Nights and makes any necessary arrangements related to the event.

Lenten Meal Coordinator – Responsible for preparing, serving, and cleaning up a meal following Stations of the Cross on Home & School's designated date during Lent.

Teacher Appreciation Coordinator – Responsible for planning one monthly event to recognize and show appreciation for the school's teachers.

"Fun" Raisers Coordinator – Seeks out and administers those programs which raise money from activities in which parents already participate (i.e. Scrip Program).

Babysitting Coordinator – Ensures babysitters are available for certain Home & School events (may work with the 8th Grade Liaison to accomplish this).

Uniform Exchange Coordinator – Keeps an inventory of uniforms donated by school patrons and makes them available free to interested families.

Class Representative – Works in conjunction with Home & School to provide support as needed.
