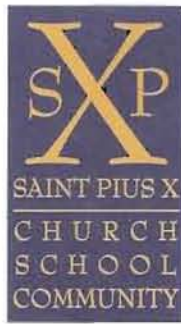

Dear St. Pius Parishioners,

Today I wish to share with you some unexpected news about my role as pastor at St. Pius X.

Last week I had a meeting with Bishop Slattery to discuss a ministry need that has arisen in the wider US Church since my appointment as pastor on June 23, 2011.

Fr. Bill Dickinson, the National Director of the Catholic Leadership Institute, a 20 year old apostolate whose primary purpose is to respectfully and responsibly provide leadership training, skill building, and consulting in service to the Roman Catholic Church asked Bishop Slattery if I could join him and his ministry team full time in this powerful and growing ministry.

This request came as a shock and surprise to both Bishop and me. Having just begun my time as pastor of St. Pius X made our decision extremely difficult. Yet after much prayer and discernment as well as a mindfulness of the needs of our larger US Church, both Bishop and I feel this is where the Holy Spirit may be calling me.

In accepting this new position, I will become the Ministry Development Manager for the Catholic Leadership Institute based in Wayne, PA. This five year appointment which will begin on November 28, 2011 will enable me to work with priests and lay leaders all across the United States as I manage two ongoing formation programs, *Good Leaders Good Shepherds* (for priests) and *Tending the Talents* (for lay leaders).

On November 5-6, 2011, I will celebrate my last Mass with you as your pastor. Coincidentally, on that same weekend, we will be celebrating our annual Stewardship Renewal. You may be thinking "this is bad planning" yet just as I call you to truly reflect upon how you will give sacrificially of yourself in the coming year through your gifts of *Time, Talent and Treasure*, I too, in a very real way, will be stepping far outside of my comfort level as I plan to embrace a ministry much different than I have ever experienced.

As you can imagine I am torn within. Your openness, hospitality and willingness to be led these past three months have drawn me into your lives and you into mine. Therefore, letting go of this amazing community is not something I have taken lightly or I find easy. However I believe God is calling me to step out in faith, trusting that His ways are not always my ways.

Bishop Slattery has assured me that your new pastor will be named before we celebrate our weekend Masses. I will share this news with you then.

Let us pray for and support one another during this time of unexpected transition.

The Wonderful Gift of Self Control

Many of us think that our children will “learn” self control through osmosis. “Isn’t that what our parents did”? We do not remember being “taught” how to wait patiently or resist sticking our finger into the icing of a freshly baked cake, we just “learned” how to wait. In reality, most children learn self control by watching others.

The difference in past generations and our current generation is that our “life style” simply required that we have patience and patience is a bi-product of self control. If you really LOVED the movie The Wizard of OZ (even though you had nightmares about the flying monkeys) you had to wait until next year to see it, Saturday morning cartoons...well they aired on SATURDAY only. Wanted to call a friend, uh oh, your older brother is sitting on the kitchen floor, ear attached to the receiver and he is talking to the “new girl” at school, might as well write a letter! It just might get there more quickly.

Today, our measurement system is so unbelievably fast, that our work, play and socialization actually promote impatience, yikes! Instant messaging, face book, 24/7 cell phone usage, video chats, the list goes on and on, We have become a generation of “give it to me now” or we feel as though we are being left behind.

Unfortunately our “neurological muscle” has not caught the technological urgency fever and so, our brain still develops and matures at approximately the same rate it always has (Developing up to age 22 on average).

Are there things we can do to accelerate that growth and development, well, kind of. We can stimulate our brain with various enrichment opportunities in order to maximize our capacity to learn and mature. But one of the best ways to actually “help” our brain to develop and reach its full potential is to restrict or eliminate those experiences that arrest healthy growth and development. Constant **one way** stimulus like television, computer or cell phone games, suck children into a virtual world that gives a rush but requires nothing

that stimulates healthy synopsis like eye contact, reading, active listening and self control. So how can we encourage brain development through self control?

For younger children, activities and games that create “good listeners” or opportunity to increase “focus” are simple and vintage play ground favorites, Duck, Duck, Goose; Mother May I and Red Light, Green Light, give children a dose of attention strengthening fun and rekindle childhood memories for parents.

Latency age children or ages 5-10 can benefit from “family projects”.

These “projects” can be uncomplicated and teach children the importance of placing the good of others, before their own desires. Cleaning out closets, creating lap blankets for the elderly in nursing homes (no sewing required) or raking the leaves on Saturday for an elderly neighbor, gives children this age a sense that they can make a difference in the lives of others, that their actions have positive consequences and that they are a valued member of your family “team” working along side your child (children) sends a powerful unspoken message to your child and teaches them by example, the joy of delayed gratification (the sincere smiles of those you help) or the heartfelt “thank you” of a person in need, is a reward that has infinite benefits.

For teens and young adults, modeling self control is significant, since this age is instinctively impulsive, showing your child (children) what day in day out self control looks like, can have an immediate and long lasting effect.

Affiliation with sports teams for example, affords a nice opportunity to model self control. As you are watching or attending a game with your teen or young adult, remaining appropriately “excited” at times of elation as well as disappointment, tells your teen that you are in charge of your emotions instead of your emotions being in charge of you. Congratulating those on the opposing team, with a sincere, “nice game” is another way to show self respect and respect for your neighbor. Refraining from gossiping, or complaining about others or situations that may frustrate you can bring about the attention of your teen. Trust me, our children know our “hot buttons” and when they “see” them being “pushed” and their parent(s) take a deep breath and respond calmly instead of reacting emotionally, they will not only take notice, but will find great emotional relief.

Self control is something that strengthens pathways of the brain, and creates a strong positive connection to further maturation and healthy growth potential.

In the bible, God mentions wisdom, and its blessings often. James 3:17 is a nice way to look at the gift of self control.

But the wisdom that comes from heaven is first of all pure; then peace loving, considerate, submissive, full of mercy, good fruit, impartial and sincere. *James 3:17*

Now, you may be asking yourself, “How does that passage reflect the topic of self control?” If we look closely at the words that God chooses, each word reflects a form or side benefit of the root...self control. In order to be a person who promotes “peace” we must first seek to understand before we are understood, slow to anger and a person who desires peace. This requires a great deal of self control.

Considerate, submissive, impartial, all of these character traits require a deep measure of self control, the focus is off of our own wants and needs and focused lovingly on the needs of others.

As we approach the season of “giving” and family gatherings, you may find that you have a more opportunity than you ever dreamed to model self control for your family. And of all the gifts we give our children and ourselves, self control has the best chance of being treasured for many years to come.

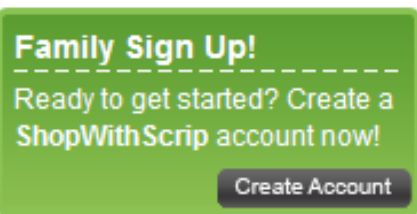
Who Can Use ShopWithScrip?

Select two challenge questions and provide answers. These answers will be required if you forget your password. They are case-sensitive.

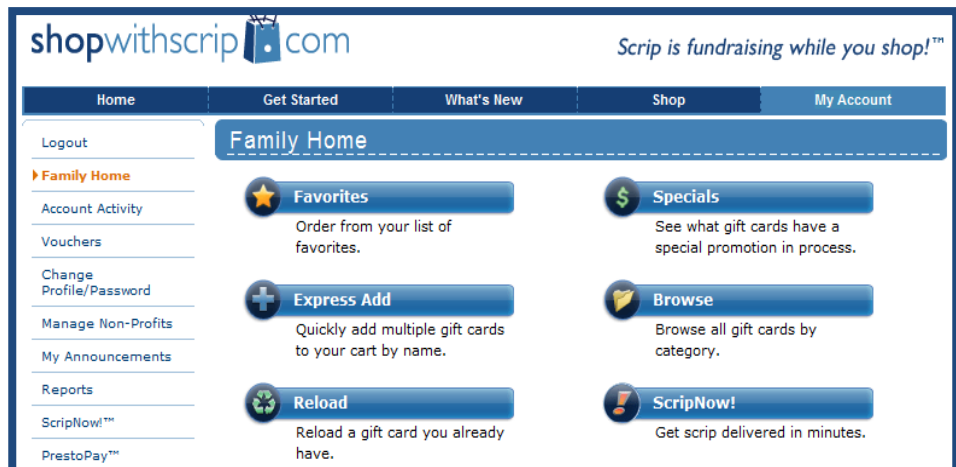
