I understand that the Tulsa Run may be canceled in the sole judgment and discretion of the sponsors if unsafe conditions exist due to rain, snow, sleet, hail, lightning, heat, civil disturbance, strikes, or other circumstances. I further agree that the starting time of the race may be changed at the sole discretion of the sponsors. Any revised starting time will be announced in the Tulsa World. I understand that while I am participating in the Tulsa Run I may be photographed by the sponsors or their agents. I agree to allow my photograph to be taken and to be used as the sponsors see fit. I understand that although police protection will be provided, there will be a possibility of traffic on the course. I assume the risk of running in traffic. I agree to yield to all emergency vehicles.
