- Catholic Schools Week **“Faith, Academics, Service”** will be the week of January 29 – February 2. Please see the attached information for the schedule of events!
- **100 Books in a 100 Days:** The last day for 100 Books in 100 Days (Kindergarten through fifth grade students only) will be Tuesday, February 14th. Students who participated in the program must have their required paperwork turned into their teachers no later than Friday, February 17th.
- Families may now apply for the **FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment** for the 2012-2013 school year. Please apply online at www.factstuitionaid.com. Paper copies are also available in the school office. Deadline to register is March 15th.
- **St. Pius X School is now accepting enrollment for the 2012-2013 Kindergarten class.** If your child will be 5 by September 1, 2012, please call the school office at 918-627-5367 during regular hours (7:30 a.m. – 3:30 p.m.) to get your child’s name on our kindergarten list. Testing for incoming

kindergarten students will be offered on Saturday, January 28th or Saturday, February 4th. There is no charge for testing.

- **Preschool Enrollment** – If you are interested in enrolling your child in the St. Pius X Preschool program for the 2012-2013 school year, please call the school office at 918-627-5367. Your child's name will be placed on a list and you will be contacted in February to begin enrollment. Please remember that your child must be 3 by September 1, 2012.
- **Pius Perks - Land a New Family (K – 8) and Earn a Sizable Tuition Credit.** For every new student who enrolls, attends, and pays tuition in 2012-2013, a SPX School family can earn a \$250 tuition credit. For every new student in the 2012 – 2013 3rd grade, the tuition credit will be \$500. No limit on number of discounts which can be earned. Please note: *Credit is for "new" students (that is, not returning ones). SPX families know we already offer Tulsa's most generous "multiple child discount" (more than 70 of our families benefit). We'll prorate the credit when the same new family enrolls several students.* Reference needed at time of enrollment.

Application deadlines are set by the school or institution awarding the scholarships. If you are applying after a given deadline date, please contact your school or institution to ensure that your application will be accepted.

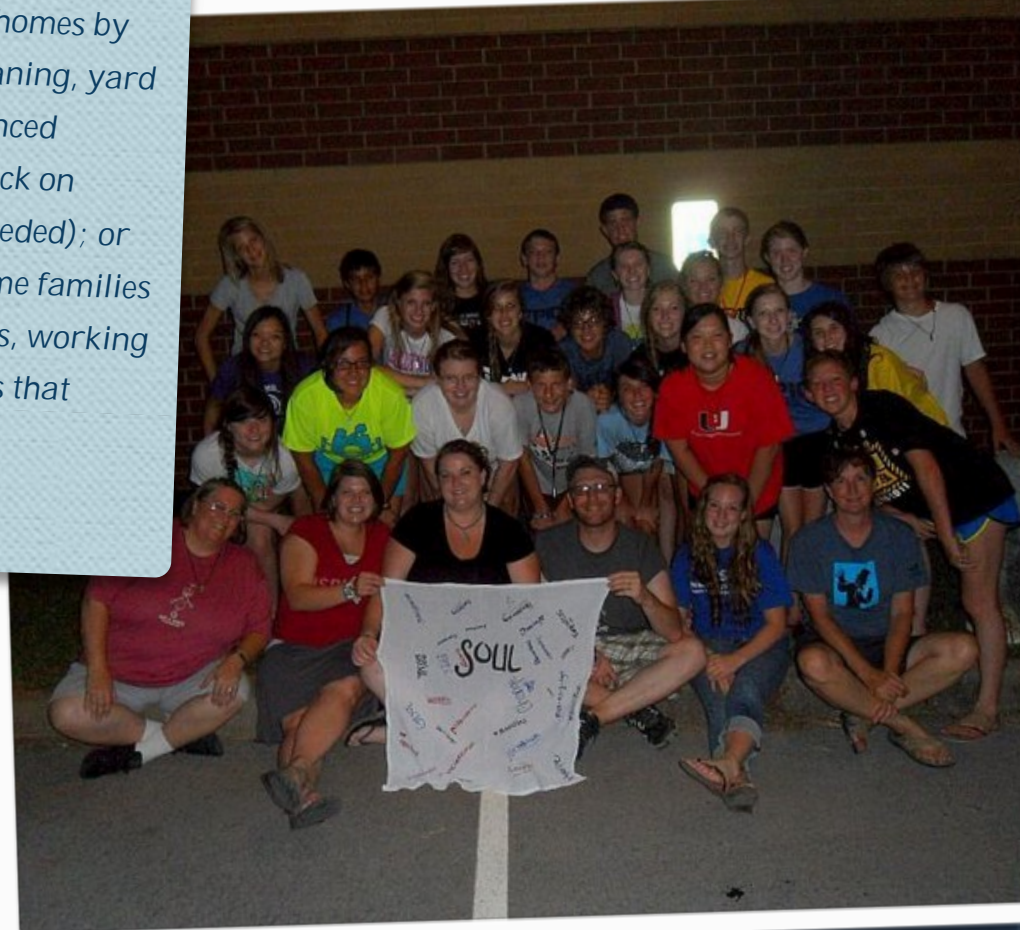
