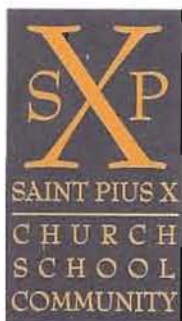

APPALACHIAN CHRISTMAS PROJECT

Dear Parents,

For over 20 years, St. Pius X School has sponsored the Christmas Store in Appalachia. This worthy cause helps the poor mountain people in Eastern Kentucky celebrate Christmas with happiness and dignity.

Sister Kathleen Weigand, OSB is the Director of the St. Vincent Mission in David, Kentucky. Sister Kathleen sponsors the Christmas Store, which serves the mountain people. Christmas Store invitations are sent to families who are selected according to their needs. In the invitations, Sister Kathleen encloses gift certificates that the parents can use at the store in exchange for gifts that they have chosen for their family. As the family leaves the store, they are given food certificates, which in turn can be redeemed at several local food markets where the families shop for their Christmas Dinner.

Sister Kathleen writes: "Plans are being made for our annual Christmas Store. This year we have noticed an increase in the needs of the families of the working poor. The gap seems to continue to widen between income and basic needs such as housing, gasoline, utility and medical costs. Your generous donations will help make the Christmas Store 2010 possible to provide gifts and Christmas dinner to many who would otherwise go without.

We wish you could be with us to see the faces of those who receive your gifts and to hear their heartfelt words of thanks along with feeling their hugs and sometimes seeing their tears.

You and your loved ones are in our prayers this Holy Season as we work together to share the love of God with the poor of Eastern Kentucky."

If you also believe that those who struggle with material poverty should receive help in a way that allows them to maintain dignity, then we invite you to participate with us in the Christmas Store. We have always had a huge response from the St. Pius X families and we hope this year will be no exception.

You can help by donating new clothes, toys, household items or money. Suggested gift items are listed on the back of this letter. A donation of \$30 will provide a food certificate from a local grocery store for a Christmas dinner for a family of four. Checks should be made payable to: St. Vincent Mission. Your donation will be tax deductible.
